### "HOT" COMPETITION – RACE REPORT SATURDAY 9 DEC 2023

When we left our home in Faulconbridge in the Blue Mountains at 7:45am, it was already 32 degrees. When we emerged from the car at Rathmines, it was like walking into a fan forced oven with a temp of 38 degrees at 10am!

Despite the 41 degree prediction, there was a good roll-up of boats and crews with eight boats facing the starter (*Dejavu* with Chris and "Crispy" from Walca). *Jocomo* and *Eirene* were scratchings due to their crews being affected by the persistent Covid virus. *Free Spirit* was an early casualty when their outboard wouldn't select either forward or reverse gear.

The rest of us (*Plastique*, *Biddy*, *Seas the Moment*, *Amethyst*, *Aye Sea Red*, *Sailaway* and *True North*) set off towards Wangi Point with a light NW breeze at our backs. This first leg was extremely hot with no shade the way the sails were set. All the boats were close at Wangi Pt however, *Seas the Moment*, a visiting Castle 650 had taken a more northerly course and were first to pick up the unforecasted brisk NE wind change.

The course took us around Pulbah Island to port, Middle Rock mark and then home. *Plastique* was first around the Middle Rock mark but had troubles putting in a reef in the building NE which was now 15 knots gusting to 18+ knots. At least the breeze was cooler. We debated about putting in a reef as we had our no. 2 jib on but I knew if we did we could kiss goodbye to the other two Castles in the race. Always a race within a race with other boats of the same class. We only had to get around Pulbah and Wangi Pt. and then we'd be ok.

Our second retirement was *Sailaway* when their bottom gudgeon bracket on their rudder broke as they approached the Middle Rock mark.

On *True North* we were significantly over powered heading into the strong NE wind but by feathering to windward to spill wind from the sails when needed, we not only pointed higher than the other two Castles (*Biddy* and *Seas the Moment*) but seemed to maintain speed with them. Once around the island we worked our way north east up close to the shallows in the hope of getting smoother water. This proved the case and as we approached Wangi Pt. we were able to slightly ease our headsail and with the breeze just starting to calm a bit, things became more comfortable.

From Wangi Pt. it was a beam reach home. With the main traveller eased out and plenty of backstay on to twist off the top of the mainsail, we romped home. *Biddy* was next followed closely by *Seas the Moment*. A good day for the Castles in Noelex weather!

## COMMENTS ON HEAT STRESS

A few crews were affected by some minor heat stress symptoms. Despite drinking large quantities of iced water, I was affected as I had been in the heat the day before and Kerry’s IWatch was indicating an elevated pulse rate. Although the race only went for about two and a half hours, the time involved rigging, pre start and post finish activities including the Xmas Party had us in a hot environment for an extended period.

Some of us managed better than others in the heat. A good remedy for most was taking a swim or cold shower in the amenities block afterwards. Others tipped buckets of water over themselves during the race which was an effective measure and we will do this in future when needed. Post Dr Google reading highly recommends this external cooling method and sitting in the shade. An air conditioned room is even better but not as much fun as sailing!!
