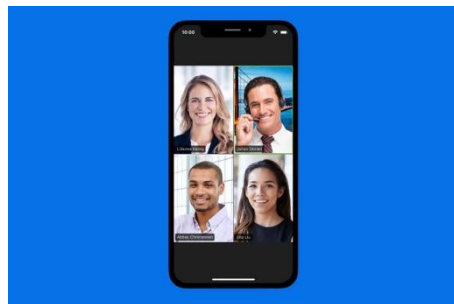

Item 9. Improvements called for on how to make the zoom meetings more user friendly, please send to Jamie A?

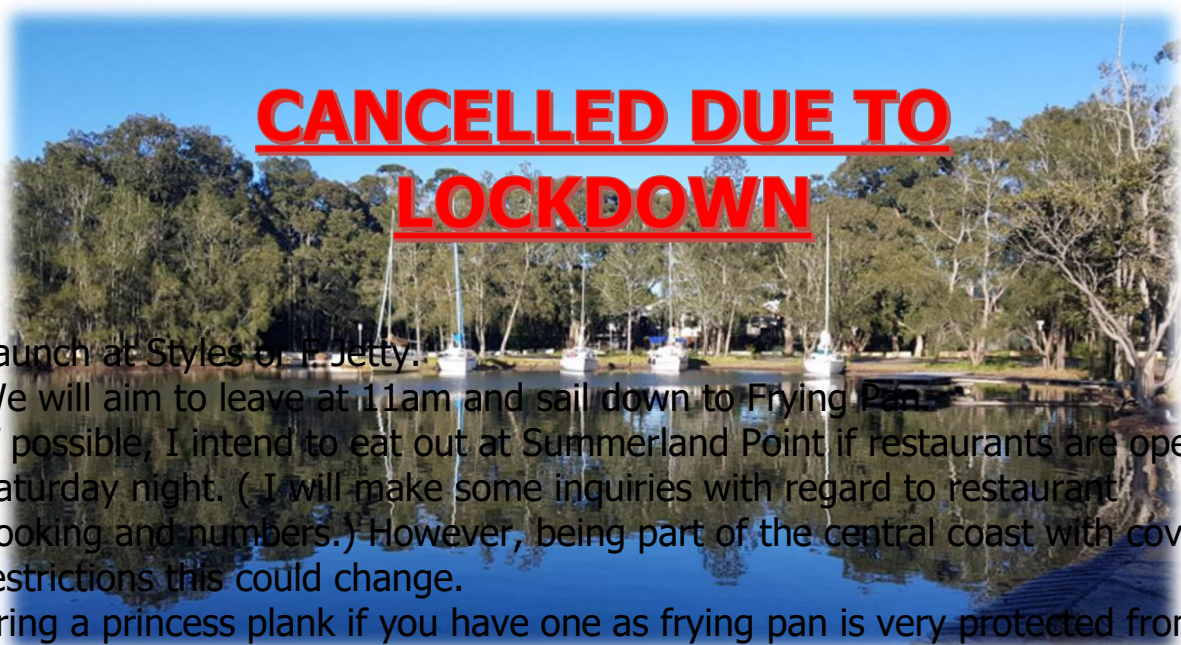

Bring a princess plank if you have one as frying pan is very protected from all wind directions but muddy. (or a bucket to wash feet)

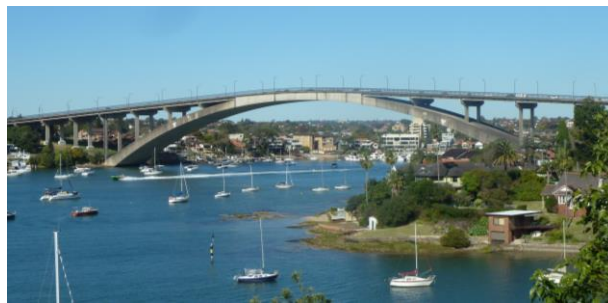

Tips for doing your Category 7 Audit

With the COVID pandemic hanging over everybody and not knowing when we can resume Racing and Cruising, I thought I'd start a segment on how to prepare for your audit.

First Aid Kits

Items as listed in Section 4.07.9, shall be stored in a **waterproof container(s)** which shall have the contents listed so as to **be visible without opening**. Remember that some items have a **"use by date"** and need to be replaced as required.

Below is a sample contents list that I use, and also the expiry dates. It is stuck to the underside of the clear lid and is a simple way of showing your contents without having to open your kit.

Please note that I carry more items in my kit than listed on the Cat 7 Audit form.
