VHF RADIO OPERATOR PROTOCOL by Peter Melbourne

There is a correct way to use and speak on the Marine VHF radio system. This is why a competency certificate is required for the Marine VHF radio network. It becomes even more important when calling for help or assisting others in an emergency.

The presentation will cover the basics of the VHF radio system, how we should speak on it during our race and cruise weekends so as to not attract concerns, and also when and how to use channel 16 in an emergency.

2021 Spring Series Race 2 Report

Sunday the 24th October, morning race preparations started with a lot of talk about the weather predictions but again the wind was not as strong as the forecast predicted but still it had a bit of a kick in it .

Race committee agreed to set a course inside Kilaben Bay with the triangle extending around to the F jetty bay with the breeze blowing ESE straight into Kilaben Bay.

From the start line the first mark was straight into the breeze making it hard going but once round the first mark it was a roller coaster ride to the second mark and then after rounding the second mark it was a spirited sailing to get past the start line for another lap, division one boats were lapping it in around 25 minutes.

Division One start was 12pm with *Farrgo* getting a cracking start over *Amethyst* with both of them sailing very hard against each other for the complete three laps swapping the lead several times with Mark (*Farrgo*) finally getting a good lead with one mark to round only to sail too close to Styles Point into it's wind shadow, letting *Amethyst* past.

With no division two, division three started at 12.10 with *Free Spirit* getting the jump on *Farr 2 Sirius* and *Crosswind*, with *Jocimo* and *Aye Sea Red* passing through the start line struggling with the conditions but trying valiantly to catch up.



Sixth yacht in division three was *Full of Rascals* but where are they, nowhere to be seen, oh there they are battling the conditions from Jamie's mooring trying to get the start. Well they made it better late than never, well done Jamie and Garry.

Free Spirit couldn't hold off *Farr 2 Sirius* and *Crosswind*, with Brian pulling away chasing down the division one yachts whilst *Crosswind* and *Free Spirit* were having a great battle with *Crosswind* coming out on top of their battle.

The two remaining *Noalex's*, *Jocimo* and *Aye Sea Red* had a great battle following the leaders with *Aye Sea Red* coming home in front, with *Full of*

Rascals tagged along but a lap down.

The racing was a great spectacle with notable sailing from Mark (solo), Dot (well done), and Dave Denahy crewing with Graeme on *Crosswind*. Garry helped on *Full of Rascals* with Jamie not giving up and finishing the race even though they were a lap down.

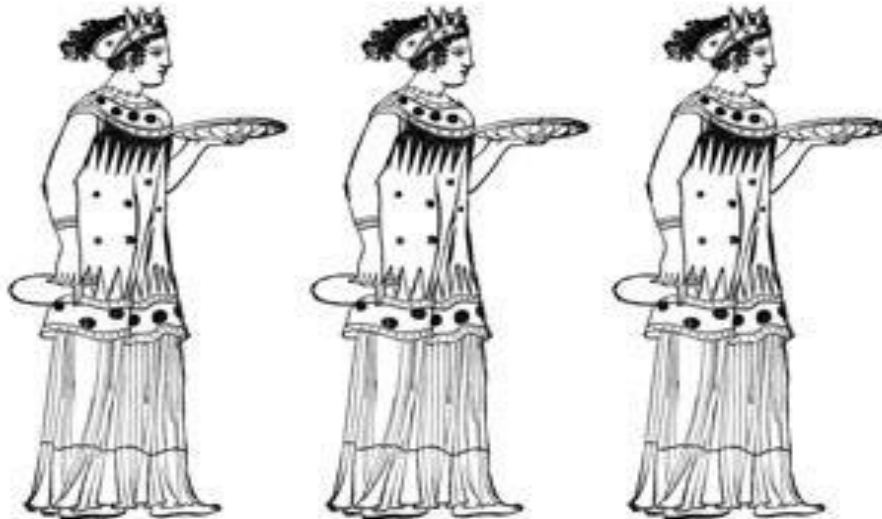
