



Myall Lakes 2023

Friday 7th April to Monday 10th April

This year we will again attempt to start and finish the 4-day long weekend cruise at 'Nerong'.



Nerong is about 10 Kms south of Bulahdelah on the highway, as you turn in off the highway you just follow it around for about 1km and the ramp is down on the right. It is a single ramp with a jetty/wall running parallel to the shore, the rigging area is limited, we usually park the cars and trailers along the road [it's as safe as anywhere] at the top of the ramp access road. Also, if you turn right out of the ramp and follow the road along there is trailer parking (sign posted) along the road on both sides. For those that get there early you can over night on one of the public moorings close by or the public jetty across from the ramp. If you are unsure ring me, and I will give a more detailed idea of where to find them.

If you can let us know you are attending that would be nice and we won't leave without you.



From Nerong township we will head out into Nerong Creek, across the Broadwater, Mungo, Bomba Point and Two Mile for the first night.

All going to plan, by the end of the weekend we will get to Nerani Sands, River Mouth, Reedy Point, Cataway, Shelly Beach, Blossom, Johnsons, Two Horse, Tait's etc.

Last year we spent time putting together a "Star Raft" which was a new thing to a lot of attendees, this will happen again.

Hopefully the gods will be kind to us and the water will be swimmable, of course there will be a Seasonal egg hunt.

As usual you will need to bring your own water, food and fuel for the whole trip. The only shop is at Myall Shores and that has very limited stock. Fuel and water is not available anywhere, the closest coming from Newcastle way would be at the servo at the old Ayres Rock or Raymond Terrace.

Planning on having a fire some nights, so a of bags of wood to share would also help.



National Parks passes are not required for this trip as we are launching at Nerong.
