Good morning Ken,

In response to your email requesting permission for overnight mooring.

Vessels associated with the Newcastle and Hunter Trailer Yacht Association are permitted to occupy Rathmines F jetty for an extended period (3.00pm through to 11.00am the next day) on the following dates;

- Friday 12 and Saturday 13 April. Sailing.
- Friday 17 and Saturday 18 May. Sailing.
- Friday 24 May – Cruise location TBC. Saturday 25 May TBC
- Friday 9 June – Cruise location TBC. Saturday 10 June TBC
- Friday 21 and Saturday 22 June for boats participating in “Float Your Boat.”
- Friday 9 and Saturday 10 August. TBC maybe cruise.
- Friday 23 and Saturday 24 August. Safety Audit Day, TBC as boats may not be launched.
- Friday 7 and Saturday 8 September – start of sailing season.

Permission is subject to the following conditions:

1. An outer section of the F jetty face, nominally 14 metres long, is available for all other vessels to embark or disembark.
2. Ensure competent persons attend to vessels occupying the jetty in case any vessel requires removal at short notice.
3. Rubbish generated by the stay is to be removed from the jetty and reserve to ensure park waste receptacles are not overloaded.
4. No power cords or water hoses are to lie on the jetty.
5. Advise NSW Roads and Maritime Services of this approval.
6. A copy of this email is always on site and produced to a person of authority on demand.
7. Any changes to this agreement (additional dates or changes to existing) requires further permission from the undersigned council officer.
