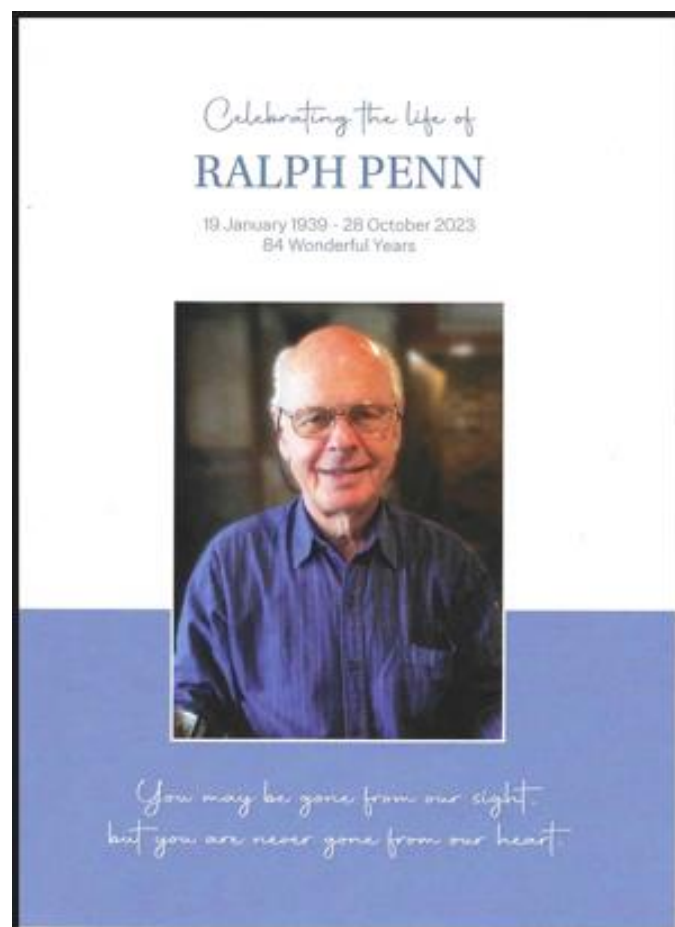

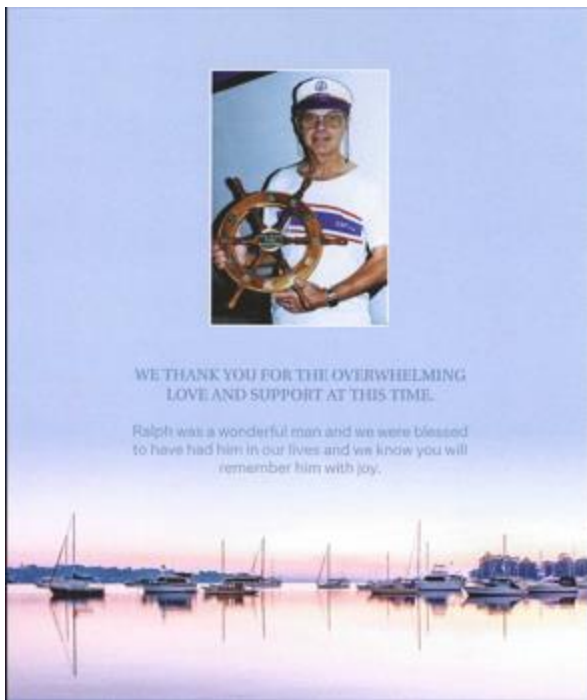

Race Reports

Race 3 Saturday 14th Oct 2023

Wind: N/W 6 to 10 Knots

Course: Pulbah Is. (Starboard) and return to Start / Finish Line Killaben Bay

John Haig and crew Russell Martin (Russell, prospective new member) Sailing JOCIMO Noelex 25

The fleet got away to a good start, I believe FREESPIRIT (Barry and Darrel) an excellent start 2 sec late over the line, Jocimo 10 sec late. Most of the fleet stayed together and favored the middle to southside of the course heading towards Wangi Pt.

We on JOCIMO choose a more northern course and stayed out wide. At Wangi Pt the fleet caught up having to deal with the Wind Shadow coming off the Point. From memory TRUE NORTH (Peter and Kerry) and JOCIMO stayed out wide East of the point and took a direct line for the old Gas Bouy mark, with PLASTQUE (Brian and Val) some distance west.

JOCIMO was first around East side of Pulbah Is. with PLASTQUE close behind, Brian suggested tightening the Cunningham to

improve the shape of our Main Sail, but have issues that need to be addressed. PLASTQUE was the first boat to round Pulbah Is. not far ahead of JOCIMO and downwind pulled away, only to catch up again in that Wind Shadow at Wangi Pt.

Looking back FREE SPIRIT was the next boat in sight, travelling well on the West side of Pulbah Is.. PLASTQUE and JOCIMO desperately trying to find a breeze to clear Wangi Pt. with FREE SPIRIT soon joining us on the South side of the Wind Shadow. We on JOCIMO noticed SEA FARR E (FARR 750 new members Simon and Samantha Parr) sailing nicely out towards Swansea mark so we followed suite, only to find they were Motor Sailing and following the NHTYA fleet. Here we are out wide watching the majority of boats rounding Wangi Pt. in close, PLASTQUE in the lead with FREE SPIRIT, our main opposition, looking dangerous also clearing the point.

Somehow with "Heaps of Luck and Pure Skill" of course, we took advantage of the Wind Shifts and put distance on FREE SPIRIT, and by then PLASTQUE well in the lead. Nearing the Finish Line we looked a comfortable 2nd place over the line, so the Skipper thought time to celebrate, and cracked a Coldie. WRONG! We were hit by a sudden gust of wind a few hundred meters from the line, experiencing an out of control ROUND UP, an extra tack, and precious time. At least we entertained the Duty Officers on EIRENE Commodore Robbin Parker and Vice Commodore Greg Cross. Thanks to you guys and Race organiser Peter Melbourne, Race Handicapper Brian Harrison also my crew Russell Martin.

A PERFECT DAY'S SAILING

Race Report Sunday 15 October 2023

We woke on Sunday to lovely weather and the dulcet tones of high performance outboards tuning up for the F1 powerboat racing at Rathmines. Ah the serenity!

Overnight Kerry and I had recovered from our scurvy symptoms acquired in yesterday's race when we sailed into a never-ending wind hole. I needed therapy for my frustration and Kerry needed therapy due to being trapped on a small boat with a frustrated me.

Anyway, today was a new day and more importantly a different wind direction and a favourably adjusted handicap rating from yesterday's unfortunate results (get over it Peter!).

John and Dot Haig on *Jocomo* set an excellent start line and a flawless start procedure. We won't talk about yesterday's line set by no less than our Commodore and Vice Commodore! Yeah, yeah, we heard the story about the dragging anchor.

We chose an Easterly Course as it is shorter than the North East course and we had more chance of completing it in the light winds. This proved to be a lovely course to sail.

We timed our start well but *Crosswind* hit the line at speed to windward and was soon in front. We took a gamble and stayed close to the shore up to Coal Point and this paid off with good breeze the whole way. When we crossed tacks with *Crosswind* she was still in front. It was a windward work to the LMYC mark with slightly sprung sheets.

The mark was hard to see due to a few fishing boats right on the mark. What is it with fishing boats and yacht racing marks? Do the marks attract fish? I know they attract racing yachts. We followed *Crosswind* around the mark with *Plastique* (Brian and Val), the Noelexes *Free Spirit* Barry White and Daryl and *Aye Sea Red* Ken Hill and crew. They were followed by *Amethyst* (easier to spell than say!) Will and Sue, *Eirene* Greg and Robin, and new members *Gilt Edge* Farr 750 Paul Webster and crew. Garry Chalmers took the opportunity to take his delightful mum out for a sail by following the fleet around in *Coconut Duck*.

From LMYC it was a fast reach to Marks Pt mark and then downwind to Coal Point mark in a lighter patch of breeze. On this leg some of the boats behind started to make ground with a steadying breeze of 8 to 10 knots. We worked hard at trying to catch *Crosswind* on the work back to Andersons but Graeme was sailing well on his own with his cooperative electronic helmsperson. Not sure what the pronoun is.

It was a long downwind run/broad reach all the way back to Rathmines. We poled out our headsail for as long as we could and managed to hold off the fast finishing *Plastique* under a blue spinnaker.

We were close enough behind *Crosswind* to pick up first on PBH and second on CBH with *Amethyst* sailing a great last leg to pick up first on CBH.

It was one of those perfect sailing days. Sunny weather moderated by a steady cool nor-easter. Great competition with friends who enjoyed the day as much as we did. We only made one mistake on the day and that was back at the boat ramp. And as I'm the report writer I can choose not to write about it! But thanks to those who helped me out.

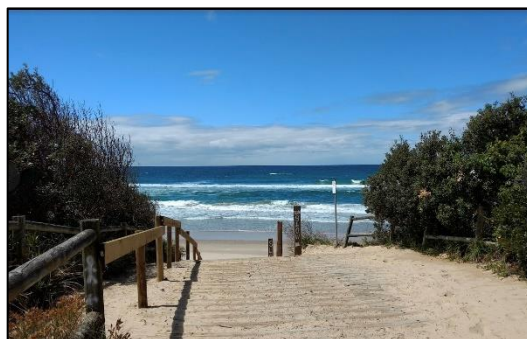
This is a great river to sail- there is a race in January that many club members have competed in however not so many trailer sailers these days.
